You'll gain job experience in a wide range of job skills, build camaraderie with fellow interns through work and planned events, and have the opportunity for spiritual growth individually, with other interns, and our various camp groups.

The program has been growing and changing since its inception, and we hope that this summer will be the best one yet. Interns will live out the servant leadership that we see modeled by Jesus in the Gospels. It is an opportunity for those who feel called to do so to put the needs of others above their own needs. We invite you to prayerfully consider spending an entire summer on Holy Ground, and we appreciate your interest in serving as a summer nurse intern at Disciples Crossing Camp. 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JOB DESCRIPTION

It takes a lot to run a camp, including: grounds upkeep, general maintenance, housekeeping, food prep and service, camp registration paperwork and office assistance, lifeguarding, programming implementation (anything from inflating bouncy houses to making play dough and a little bit of everything in between), and providing medical care. You will be involved in the medical aspects of the camp's ministry with the possibility of helping in several of the other areas.

Reports To:

The Director of Programming is our Summer Intern Coordinator and liaison. However, as a medical provider you will also work with our Medical Director and Executive Director.

Job Overview:

This position is responsible for managing the healthcare and First Aid needs of campers. The nurse intern will help with daily distribution of camper medications in accordance with doctors' prescriptions, will administer First Aid when needed, and will ensure the safety of campers and all participants at all times. A commitment is required for 10 weeks.

Summer Schedule, Perks, and Pay:

You will be paid every other week, \$300 per week, or less if you work a partial week. (Interns are not full-time employees and therefore will not be paid for time off) Your season begins at 10:00 am on June 1, 2021

Your season ends on August 7, 2021

Most weeks you will be off after clean up on Saturday until dinner on Sunday. You will be provided housing with other interns of the same gender in bunks rooms with a shared meeting space for all interns that includes a small kitchen and lounge area. Most meals are provided. Interns will have to provide their own meals when no campers are on site (ex: weekends)

Fall-Spring:

Depending on performance over the summer, interns will have the opportunity to work weekend retreats during the fall, winter, and spring. We will provide more details on offseason work opportunities by the end of your summer season.

Responsibilities and Duties:

You will occasionally be "on-call" overnight to assist camp directors

Interact with campers and full time staff to ensure all reasonable camp needs are met; willingly listening to and assisting others with their requests

Complete tasks as assigned by Summer Intern Coordinator or other full-time staff in a wide-range of skill sets

Maintain a positive and productive attitude and relationship with other interns and camp staff

Participate in scheduled events, trainings, and all work-related tasks

QUALIFICATIONS & APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Qualifications:

At least 18 years of age

Must pass Food Handlers Safety Course (can be completed after hire) Must be Lifeguard and CPR certified (can be completed after hire) Must be able to live on-site and work irregular hours as asked by full-time camp staff Physical requirements include working on your feet for long hours, experiencing temperature extremes, bending over and lifting heavy items, and more Must be reliable, on time for work, consistent and efficient in completing tasks Must have a positive attitude and be able to work independently as well as with a team.

Preferred (Not Required) Qualifications:

At least one year of college or post-secondary education successfully completed (additional job experience may be substituted for college/university studies) Lifeguard and CPR certification prior to hire Food Handlers Safety Certification prior to hire Prior experience in camp ministry Prior job experience related to any routine tasks as Summer Intern (manual labor, food service, housekeeping, administrative, ministerial)
